RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe in order to preserve and protect the health and general welfare of the Tribe pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, hereby recognizes the importance of formally accepting the FEMA Staffing for Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant to provide necessary personnel needed to protect members of the Tribe and it's guests as a part of the Pyramid Lake Fire Rescue/EMS program; and


WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Fire Rescue/EMS Department in conjunction with the finance department shall be charged with maintaining proper reporting for the duration of the grant and report as needed to the Tribal Council. The PLFR/EMS shall follow Tribal Personnel Policies as well as specific departmental policy under the direction of the Emergency Response Coordinator and the Tribal Council; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the acceptance of the FEMA SAFER Grant.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Pyramid Lake Tribal Chairman and/or designee to effectuate any and all administrative actions necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

CERTIFICATION

It is hereby certified that the foregoing resolution of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, composed of ten members, of whom nine (9) constituting a quorum were present at a meeting duly held on the 21st day of September, 2018 was adopted by the affirmative vote of six (6) FOR and two (2) AGAINST, with zero (0) ABSTENTIONS; pursuant to the authority contained in the Constitution and By-laws of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.
