RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs to negotiate with federal, state, and local governments; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council is the duly elected governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe charged with the responsibility of establishing policy and taking action to preserve and protect the health/welfare of the Tribal membership and to appropriate available Tribal funds; and
- WHEREAS, income generated from royalty payments are deposited into the U.S. Treasury Trust Account No. PL 7280-70-1 by the Office of the Special Trustee; and
- WHEREAS, the process of withdrawing these funds are through an SF 1034 and a Tribal resolution with no other restrictions in place; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes this requirement and has determined a need to streamline the process to ensure that timely deposits are made into the Tribe's General Account.
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves a resolution to cover withdrawal of 1,237,508.07 which reflects undrawn income through December 2017.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to send this authority to the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Office of the Special Trustee for file 2017 withdrawals made in 2018.
