RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE INDIAN RESERVATION NIXON, NV

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. 476) and is Federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior to negotiate with federal, state, and local governments; and
- WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, National Institute of Justice has announced its Tribal-Researcher Capacity Building Grants, CFDA 16.560, due April 23, 2018.
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, the governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, approves the grant application submission to DOJ for the current Grant competition period. The governing body agrees that it will assume the obligations imposed by applicable federal regulations and other terms and conditions of the award, including any assurances, if the grant is awarded. The governing body has the requisite authorization to implement the proposed project on tribal lands.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves and supports the submittal of the Tribe's application under the CFDA 16.560 – Tribal-Researcher Capacity Building Grants solicitation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman or his designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and sign all grant award and other future administrative documents necessary for project award and implementation.
