RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is authorized by Article VII of the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws to approve land assignments to members of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has delegated the Land and Resource Committee, a standing committee of the Tribe, with the responsibility to review applications for tribal land assignments and to make recommendations to deny or approve said assignments in accordance with tribal law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby accepts the recommendation of the Land and Resource Committee and approves the Committee's concern for the following tract listed on tribal land within the Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation:


RECOMMENDATION

The Committee is seeking a resolution to place any new land assignments applications in a moratorium. This request comes as a result of an evaluation of the existing water system and performance concerns in the communities of PLIR. The system is currently operating at max capacity and any new connections will affect the overall performance for all community users. The expansion of the sewer ponds in Sutcliffe and Wadsworth also needs to be addressed.

This will remain in effect until some alleviation to the current infrastructure allows for continued growth on PLIR.

CERTIFICATION

It is hereby certified that the foregoing resolution of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, composed of ten members, of whom nine (9) constituting a quorum were present at a meeting duly held on the 20th day of July, 2018 was adopted by the affirmative vote of four (4) FOR and two (2) AGAINST, with two (2) ABSTENTIONS pursuant to the authority contained in the Constitution and By-laws of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.
