RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe (Tribe) has been again notified by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Federal Insurance and Mitigation Administration, Hazard Mitigation Assistance Division with a notice of funding opportunity and its request for proposals for Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) projects and activities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe meets the eligibility requirements to submit a proposal addressing issues relating to sustaining cost-effective measures designed to reduce the risk from natural hazards while reduces the reliance on federal funding from future disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has identified that developing preliminary engineering reports (PER) for exposed streambanks in the lower Truckee River provides sufficient preparation to effectively apply for U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and Pyramid Lake Water Quality construction permits; and


WHEREAS, the proposed beneficiary will compliment Pyramid Lake fishery recovery and Truckee River and Pyramid Lake water quality by stabilizing streambanks and preventing erosion causing environmental detriment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council the hereby approves the grant application to request funding from the DHS FEMA for PDM program.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairman or his designee is authorized to negotiate and execute said application with the DHS FEMA.

CERTIFICATION
