RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. 476) and is Federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior to negotiate with federal, state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) through the CTAS Grant has extended a granting opportunity to support and enhance tribal efforts to prevent and reduce juvenile delinquency and strengthen a fair and beneficial juvenile justice system response for American Indian and Alaskan Native youth, the Pyramid Lake Human Services Department is applying for the CTAS Grant, Purpose Area 9.

WHEREAS, the application is due on February 26, 2019.

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe seeks to provide services to youth who have experienced violence in the home, child abuse and neglect, truancy, running away from home, and parents who are abusing substances, dating violence, and human trafficking.

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe's Police Department does not have sufficient resources for two officers to be on duty 24/7.


WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Police Department is attempting to address this problem by submitting an application for Purpose Area 1 funds to hire and train officers and re-establish a Community Action Team that will work with the Court, the probation department, victim services, the substance abuse program and the community watch groups to effect real change.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council hereby approves, supports and authorizes the submittal of the CTAS, OJJDP grant by the Human Services Department in the amount of \$790,899 and the Pyramid Lake Police Department in the amount of \$619,363.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Chairman or his designee to negotiate and sign all grant awards and future administrative documents necessary for project award and implementation.

CERTIFICATION
