## **RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA**

**WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Violence Against Women has issued a Notice of Funding Opportunity for funds under the Tribal Sexual Assault Services Program.

**WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has applied for these funds successfully over the past three years.

**WHEREAS**, the Victim Services Program seeks to continue and enhance direct services provided to child/adult victims and survivors of sexual assault and those collaterally affected.

**WHEREAS**, the application is due on March 5, 2019.


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council hereby approves, supports and authorizes the submittal of an application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women for Tribal Sexual Assault Services Program in the amount of 325,000.

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Chairman or his designee to negotiate and sign all grant awards and future administrative documents necessary for project award and implementation.
