RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, and is recognized by the United States through the Secretary of the Interior for the administration of program and services; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council (Tribal Council) is the duly elected governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, charged with the responsibility of establishing policy and taking action to preserve and protect the health and general welfare of the Tribal membership; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council established a Tribal Health Clinic in 1985 under the authority of Article VI, Section 1 (A), (D), and (M), of the Tribe's Constitution and By-Laws, adopted January 15, 1936, to provide health care services to the members of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe and eligible American Indians/Alaskan Natives, and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Health Clinic is authorized to operate under a Charter and Plan of Operations with oversight delegated to the Pyramid Lake Health Board as approved by the Tribal Council on July 12, 2002, amended March 26, 2013; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Health Clinic maintains the goal of providing public health promotion prevention activities that will improve the health of community subgroups that are at high risk of developing health problems; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Health Clinic recognizes unintentional elder fall related injuries are a leading cause of hospitalization in American Indian and Alaskan Native communities; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service, Injury Prevention Program is providing non-competing continuation grant funding for Year 5 for Elder Fall Injury Prevention; and
- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Tribal Health Clinic has developed the grant application for Year 5 for \$25,000.00 to provide elder fall education, medication

reconciliation, strength and balance exercise program, home assessments, and home modifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council hereby approves the submittal of the Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service, Injury Prevention Program grant application; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairman or his designee is hereby authorized to effectuate any and all administrative actions necessary to implement the intent of this Resolution.

CERTIFICATION
