RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe benefits from federal funding.

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has contracted out for grant writing services.

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is interested in finding a more local grant writing service.

WHEREAS, staff has contacted five Nevada-based firms and determined there was sufficient interest for a Request for Proposals

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the issuance of a Request for Proposals on April 22, 2019 by Tribal Staff.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Request for Proposals shall be posted publicly on the Tribe's website.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the deadline for responses to the Request for Proposals shall be May 22, 2019.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the responses to the proposals will be brought back to the Tribal Council at the first meeting in June and an award decision will be made by the Council at that time.
