## **RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA**

**WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, at-risk families living on the Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation would benefit from parenting classes.

**WHEREAS**, teens from at-risk families living on the Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation would benefit from group therapy.

**WHEREAS**, the State of Nevada, Department of Health and Human Services issued a Request for Applications on April 30, 2019 for Title IV funding.

**WHEREAS**, this grant, if awarded, would fund the provision of the services described above.

**WHEREAS**, a match of 25%, in cash or in-kind services, of the total project costs is required.

**WHEREAS**, the Social Services Department will use its existing funds, specifically 25% of the Director's salary to provide the required match on this grant.

**WHEREAS**, the deadline for applications is May 23, 2019.


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council authorizes the development and submittal of a Title IV Grant Application for \$37,314 to the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council authorizes the use of \$12,437 from the Social Services budget to be used as match on this grant application.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign all documents needed for submittal of the application to the State of Nevada, Department of Health and Human Services
